Nager syndrome is a rare condition associated with craniofacial malformations such as, micrognathia, zygomatic hypoplasia, external ear malformations, and preaxial deformities. This report features Nager syndrome occurring in a one-year-old boy showing microretrognathia, thumb brachydactyly, hexadactyly, and hypertrophic cardiomyopathy, characteristics not usually encountered in Nager syndrome.
